





Guidelines for Kennedy Space Center

Embarking on a trip abroad is an exciting adventure that opens up a world of new experiences. To make the most of this unique opportunity, please read this information about the Kennedy Space center trip organized and sponsored by Aakash Educational Services Limited. The following are the detailed terms & conditions for those selected for the trip. Parents should please go over the rules with their children. Failure to comply with the following rules may result in the cancellation or disqualification from the trip.

Eligibility Criteria

- Only 5 students will be selected from ANTHE 2024- 2025 out of which 2 students from the Top 100 will be chosen across all courses and streams and 3 students will be chosen from other ranks. All decisions on the winners will be taken by the Management of AESL and it will be final and binding.
- admission/ enrollment in the regular classroom program of AESL for the academic year 2025-2026 is mandatory and one must have paid the first installment before 31st December 2024. Additionally, students must maintain a minimum of 75% attendance during the travel and must be regular and active in AESL programs.
- The selected students for the trip will be allowed to be accompanied along with one parent only for the trip.

Trip Details

- Venue: Kennedy Space Center Florida (USA)
 - Days & Months: 5-day trip between April 2025 to December 2025**.
- **Specific dates for the trip will be communicated to each student/parent individually by the written communication at the later dates. Aakash Educational Services Limited ('AESL') reserves the exclusive rights to change the venue, time, and place of the trip at AESL's sole discretion or in the event of any exceptional circumstances.
- This trip **includes** the following expenses for one student and one parent
 - a. Airfare expenses. (round trip)
 - b. One room accommodation shall be provided to Student and Parent for a maximum period of 5 days.
 - c. Entry tickets to Kennedy Space Center.
 - d. The documentation and processing of the visa shall be done by the student(s)/Parent(s) and the expenses for the same shall be borne by AESL.
 - This trip **excludes** the following
 - a. Any other family member accompanying the student other than one parent will be at the sole cost of the individual and excluded from AESL sponsorship.
 - b. Any other site visit charges other than Kennedy Space Center will be at the sole cost of the individuals.

Terms and Conditions

- It is clearly understood and agreed that trip shall be subject to the guidelines as may be applicable from time to time. In the event of partial cancellations or partial VISA rejections, AESL reserves the right to cancel or postpone the trip at its sole discretion.
- Transport (round trip) will be arranged from the Airport to the hotel and the Kennedy Space Center apart from this transport AESL shall not be responsible for any transport charges.
- It is clearly understood that AESL is responsible for sponsoring only one parent of the student for the trip and in the event other parent wants to accompany the student on the trip, AESL shall not be liable to make such arrangements. All the arrangements shall be made at the sole cost and efforts of the individual.
- Trip cannot be conducted where there are less than 4 students for the trip for any reasons whatsoever. AESL reserves the right to cancel or postpone the trip if the selected students are less than 4.
- AESL must be informed in writing or through email anthesupport@aesl.in of any changes by student/parent in the scheduled trip after all the reservations and necessary arrangements are made by AESL 15 days in advance. Such student/ parent will be disqualified from the trip and AESL shall not be liable in any circumstances and for any reasons whatsoever for such disqualification.

A. ANTHE REGISTRATION AND PROCEDURE

1. Students/ parents/ guardian ("You", "Your") can either register for ANTHE at the AESL website: <https://anthe.aakash.ac.in> or submit the duly filled forms available at the nearest branch along with a self-attested photocopy of class VI / VII / VIII / IX / X / XI & XII mark-sheet (as applicable), one passport size color photograph. In case a mark sheet is not available, You can enroll by submitting a self-attested photocopy of Your Identity Card issued by the school.
2. ANTHE is conducted in two exam modes i.e., in offline and online mode. Students can register for either of the exam modes through the website or by visiting the branch. A non-cancellable and non-refundable fee of INR 200 shall be payable by You for attempting ANTHE in offline & Online exam mode. In any situation or circumstance whatsoever, if You wish to change the mode from offline exam mode to online exam mode or vice versa, it should be done seven days (7) in advance from the date of ANTHE exam. AESL will not refund this fee for any reason whatsoever.


B. SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The scholarship offered under ANTHE shall be applicable on One/ Two/ Three/ Four Year Integrated Classroom Courses only.

C. REVOCATION OF SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM


1. At the time of enrolment in the Classroom Program, it is mandatory to provide mark-sheet issued by the school for passing the previous class or any other document mentioning the date of birth of the student. Wherein at the time of enrolment or thereafter, it has come to the knowledge of administration of AESL that You have made multiple registrations for ANTHE using different details (mobile numbers and email IDs), management of AESL reserves the right to forfeit the scholarship granted to You with immediate effect.
2. If any student fails in his/her school exams, the scholarship offered under ANTHE, will be withdrawn & the student will be disqualified from the scholarship.
3. During the Classroom Program at AESL, a student must meet the following requirements failing which his/her scholarship program will be revoked with immediate effect. The decision of the management of AESL shall be final and binding on You.
 - a) ATTENDANCE: The attendance of the student in the coaching class should not drop below 85% throughout the Classroom Program. Minimum attendance of 85% is required for every student enrolled in Classroom Program whether the student has availed any scholarship under ANTHE or not.
