

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What is JEE (Main & Advanced) ?

The Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) is a single entrance exam in India for admission to undergraduate courses in premier Indian Institutions including IITs, NITs, IIITs, GFTIs, State Government funded institutions and other participating universities for admission in B.E./B.Tech., B.Arch., & B. Planning. JEE consists of two stages- JEE (Main) and JEE (Advanced). JEE (Main) is preliminary & qualifying exam for JEE (Advanced).

JEE (Advanced) is a national-level entrance examination conducted annually for admission into IITs. It is the second stage of JEE and can only be attempted by candidates who qualify JEE (Main). JEE (Advanced) is regarded as the toughest engineering exam in India.



Eligibility Criteria: JEE (Main)

Candidates who have passed Class 12 (or equivalent) in 2024, 2025, or appearing in 2026, with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects are eligible to apply. No age limit as per NTA guidelines.

 **Mode of Exam:** Computer Based Test (CBT)  **Duration:** 3 hours

 **Total Questions:** B.E./B.Tech: 75 Questions  **Total Marks:** 300

 **Subjects:** Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics

 **Marking Scheme:** Four (+4) marks for every correct answer, Minus one (-1) mark for every incorrect answer

 **Language:** Available in 13 languages including English, Hindi and several Regional languages



Eligibility Criteria: JEE (Advanced)

- Top 2,50,000 rank holders in JEE (Main)
- Must have passed Class 12 in 2025 or 2026
- Age criteria: born on or after October 1, 2001 (with relaxation for reserved categories)
- Number of attempts: maximum 2 in consecutive years

 **Mode of Exam:** Computer Based Test (CBT)  **Duration:** 3 hours each paper (Paper-1 & Paper-2)

 **Total Questions:** Number of Question varies every year

 **Subjects:** Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics  **Total Marks:** 360

 **Marking Scheme:** Varies every year, partial & negative marking

 **Language:** Only English & Hindi



Refund Policy

We Believe in Fairness and Clarity



The AESL works transparently. Our Refund policy ensures that all the refunds are processed fairly. In case, a student expresses his intention of not attending the course, and withdrawing his admission, we would require a refund Application/Grievance Letter from Parent/Guardian (along with the relationship) to be submitted to Branch/Centre in person stating the reason for seeking a refund. The date of submission of the written application for refund at the Branch/Centre will be considered for calculation of the refund amount. Parents/Guardians can also request for refund via mail to care@aesl.in. For refund applications via mail, the date of Email will be taken into consideration for calculation of the refund amount. The refund will be processed only in the "Savings Account" and not in any other type of account.

C NO REFUND CASES

Mode of Payment of Refund:

All kinds of refunds shall be paid through NEFT/Online Transfer ONLY. The refunds shall only be processed in the account of the student/parent/guardian as may be provided by the parent/guardian. The refund shall be credited within a reasonable time from the date of receipt of an application for withdrawal of admission by the appropriate Branch / Centre. The loan amount will be refunded to lending service provider based on AESL refund policy eligible amount only. In case any Outstanding remains with the lending service provider after refund as-per-policy amount then the same has to be cleared/Paid by the parents in coordination/accordance with the lending policies of the lending service provider. Fee Refund Calculation Basis Scholarship Earned in actual exam:

- Students eligible for scholarships should submit their application for refund based on the scholarship earned along with the photocopy of the Class X Board Exam mark sheet on or before 26th July.
- Any application for Fee refund basis scholarship earned received beyond 26th July shall be rejected and the student and/or parent shall not be entitled to receive any refund under any circumstances whatsoever.
- The Fee refund basis scholarship earned amount shall be paid to the student/parent/guardian based on the eligible merit scholarship in the 1st week of August.
